I. Agenda Item No. 01: Confirmation of the minutes of the 14th LPCC meeting:

II. Agenda Item No. 02: Finanacial powers to Chairman and Member Secretary, LPCC for incurring contingent and miscellaneous expenditures:

The Committee has approved the financial power to Chairman and Member Secretary, LPCC for incurring contingent and miscellaneous expenditure which are as follows:

- 1. Consolidated Power Delegation order F.No.25/1/2019-Fin Dated 17/05/2017 and subsequent amendments dated 14/07/2017, 06/09/2018, 12/12/2019 & 08/02/2021 and Order F.No.70/1/2022-Fin Dated 01/09/2022 delegated the financial powers to the Secretary (Concerned Dept.)/ Secretary (Finance) /Advisor to the Hon'ble Administrator, UTLA adopted as the power of Chairman, LPCC
- 2. Consolidated Power Delegation order F.No.25/1/2019-Fin Dated 17/05/2017 and subsequent amendements dated 14/07/2017, 06/09/2018,12/12/2019 and 08/02/2021 delegated the powers of Departmental Head adopted as the power of Member Secretary, LPCC

III. Inspection and quality assessment of food items from hotels/restaurants/super markets in the islands.

The Committee has discussed the matter at length and the following decisions were taken.

- (i) To Conduct "Eat Right Campaigns" regularly for the students as well as public.
- (ii) Inspections are to conducted at regular intervals and during the period of inspection advisory mode of actions are ensured.
- (iii) Performa shall be formulated for inspection of hotels/restaurant/supermarket.
- (iv) Identify the primary and secondary parameters required for the assessment of inspection.
- (v) The action shall be initiated to setting up of a laboratory facility for quality analysis of food.
- (vi) Monthly inspection report by Health Department and Legal Metrology Department shall be submitted to the Lakshadweep Pollution Control Committee

(Action by Dept. of Health Services/LPCC/ Legal Metrology)
